Some legislators increase their pension payments by taking administrative positions after they serve, which converts their pension payments from the legislator payout to a full-time employee's payout. ${ }^{[1]}$

As of 2008, the salary of Idaho's governor ranked 39th among U.S. governors' salaries. The average salary earned by U.S. governors was $\$ 128,735$. The median salary earned by U.S. governors was $\$ 129,962$. ${ }^{\text {[2] }}$
