\$17,358/year	\$129/day for members establishing a second residence in Boise; \$49/day if no second residence is established and up to \$25/day travel. Set by the compensation commission.	

Some legislators increase their pension payments by taking administrative positions after they serve, which converts their pension payments from the legislator payout to a full-time employee's payout.^[1]
